3. Treasurer's Report and Accounts

Copies of last years accounts were circulated during the meeting for comment.

Cash in hand has reduced by some £200 to £7000 but this is still a healthy position against an annual expenditure of £4100. So still a good position.

Income last year increased by £90 mainly in the areas of subscriptions from clubs and a profit at the county closed competition.

Subscriptions were slightly up on last year but we did revert back to £55 for the winter leagues. England Squash and Racketball rebate was in line with the previous year. Some clubs still have their summer league fee outstanding.

On the expenditure side there was a reduction of £400 on the previous year however there was an increase in the area of county expenses as claim levels have been raised.

In summary cash reserves have reduced by £200 but our working capital continues to be maintained in excess of one year's level of expenditure which has been our golden rule since DSRA went bust several years ago.

4. Development - Helen Wilson

The management committee has co-opted Mark Tasker and Jo Wallis to support the Development of Junior Squash in the county along with myself. Together we have formed the DSR Junior Development Team (JDT)

So far, we have pulled together information on most of the active junior players in the county, with players and parents being very supportive and appreciative of this new set-up.

Mark Tasker is an ESR UKCC level 3 advanced coach and so is well qualified to be a county coach. His main focus is junior squash, so we are very lucky to have secured his services for the county.

One of the main aims of the JDT is to provide regular and frequent coaching sessions for all the juniors to train together. The 1st of these was held at Ilkeston and it went very well being attended by 23 players from all cardinal points in the county. The next session is this coming weekend at Princes sports club.

Our role, as we see it is to make recommendations to DSR about which junior inter county teams to enter and we will look at the younger players who might be ready to play in the U11 Festival in the spring, and help the players train for, and generally support, this county activity.

Using the DSR website, we will highlight the Grand Prix events, nearby ESR sanctioned events, and county and regional training sessions, thus creating a yearly calendar which will help parents and players organize weekends well in advance.

The structure we are putting in place will help young players see their pathway through the sport and encourage participation and help retention of players in this beautiful game. **THEY ARE OUR FUTURE!**

This season has seen 58 players from Derbyshire and the surrounding counties play in these popular Junior Squash events. We have many talented young squash players and should be proud of them all. These Grand Prix events are merely a stepping stone towards bigger and better achievements for some and for others the events provide the opportunity for them to play squash at a slightly more competitive level than perhaps they are used to and they are a starting point for players to play, and enjoy, the game of squash.

As usual, events were held at Princes Club, Duffield and Ilkeston Manor and some tremendous squash has been played, not just by those in the top groups but also by some of the newcomers to the game too. I hope that many of the players will step up and play in ESR sanctioned events and represent Derbyshire at inter-county level.

13. Any other business

- John Beastall - Raised the issue of why the Men's O60 and O65 InterCounty teams play on the same night.
- Ray Patrick - England squash membership for all players competing in the Derbyshire leagues. A number of clubs have looked into this previously, Doug Whitfield to follow up on Burton Squash Clubs involvement.
- Phil Scully - the format of the 'premier' league is to be reviewed, various ideas were discussed including splitting the league into two groups of four with promotion/demotion at the Christmas break or a smaller league but playing the other teams three times instead of two. If anybody has any ideas then please email Phil and they can be discussed at the next committee meeting.
- Rolls-Royce requested that their home games be played at the start and end of the season. This is to alleviate the problem they are currently suffering from of cold courts. This should not be a problem from a league arrangement point of view as very often a team will play consecutive home matches.
- Paul Oldham - The Manor, asked if it would be possible to organize a Racketball knockout competition. This is a possibility although we are currently without a 'Racketball Coordinator'.
- La Fitness advised that the club may soon cease to exist as the current owners are trying to sell the club and site.
- The issue of PAR scoring was raised in that we should change to this format for all the divisions and not just in the 'Premier'. The issue of potential short matches was the main criticism of this scoring method although it should be possible to increase the number of points to be played to 11 or even 15. We need feedback from all the clubs on this.
